

# Route Diagram

This is a general guide to the basic DAILY service. Not all trains stop at all stations on each coloured line – please check the timetable.



First Capital Connect routes are shown in nine different colours to help identify the general pattern; see below for details.

## 1 KING'S LYNN and CAMBRIDGE

## 2 CAMBRIDGE local

## 3 PETERBOROUGH

Trains do not serve Potters Bar, Hatfield, Welwyn Garden City, Welwyn North or Knebworth on **Sundays**.

## 4 HERTFORD

Trains serve Moorgate on **Mondays to Fridays** until 22:00 only. Trains serve London King's Cross after 22:00 on **Mondays to Fridays** and all day on **Saturdays** and **Sundays** only. Trains do not serve Hitchin and Letchworth Garden City on **Sundays**.

## 5 WELWYN

Trains serve Moorgate on **Mondays to Fridays** until 22:00 only. Trains serve London King's Cross at peak times, after 22:00 on **Mondays to Fridays** and all day on **Saturdays** and **Sundays** only.

## 6 BEDFORD and BRIGHTON

Some peak hour trains operate via Elephant & Castle and not London Bridge.

## 7 LUTON, WIMBLEDON and SUTTON

Trains run anticlockwise around the Wimbledon loop and continue on route 8.

## 8 ST. ALBANS, MITCHAM and SUTTON

No **Sunday** service north of London Blackfriars. Trains run clockwise around the Wimbledon loop and continue on route 7.

## 9 KENT

Some peak hour trains also serve stations to and from Bedford and/or other destinations in Kent. Trains on **Saturdays** and **Sundays** do not operate north of London Blackfriars. Trains on this route are operated by Southeastern south of London Blackfriars.
